Virginia Grace Tucker was born on March 13, 1931, in Prosper, Texas. She was the second-oldest of six children and enjoyed school and roller skating in her youth. She married her high school sweetheart, Henry Keith Tucker, in 1949, and together they raised four beautiful children. After their children were grown, Virginia enrolled at Our Lady of the Lake University in San Antonio and earned a bachelor's degree in education. Virginia taught kindergarten in San Antonio for over 20 years. When she officially retired, she wasn't quite ready to stop teaching, so she became a substitute teacher. Many of her students called her Mrs. T.

She also traveled internationally, including to England, Scotland, Sweden, and Norway, and loved meeting new people and exploring new places.

Virginia loved her church, Southside Baptist Church, and all her friends there. She loved reading and all things mysteries. An animal lover to her core,

Virginia adored dogs and cats and never met a stray she would not bring home. Most of all, Virginia loved her family. Her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren brought her immense joy.
