Vitaly Apostolow passed away on February 4, 2021 at the age of 93. He was born in Tiraspol, Moldova on December 27, 1927 to parents Serghei and Alexandra Apostolow. He and his parents were Russian refugees of WWII who immigrated to Santiago Chile where he later met his future wife, Ina. They married and immigrated once again with both sets of parents to the United States in 1958. They were happily married for 57 years. He worked as a cartographer, then supervisor of a photogrammetrical department for over 40 years at International Aerial Mapping Company. He was fluent in several languages. He enjoyed spending time with his children and grandchildren, going to the beach, fishing and taking long weekend trips with Ina to Las Vegas. He is survived by his three children Olga Massey and husband David, Vladimir Apostolow and Tatyana Apostolow, grandchildren Heather, Calvin and Clifton Massey, Nicki Apostolow Weaver and husband Rick, Robin Balsler, Alex Adams and husband Noah, great grandchildren, Nadejda Weaver, Marley Balsler, Brianna Bocquin, Declan and Lachlan Adams.
