



## Vocial Lee Walker

April 24, 1925 - December 30, 2020

(Jenny) Vocial Lee Walker, née: Wilcox born April 23, 1925 in Norman, Oklahoma. Vocial passed into Heaven on December 29, 2020 at the age of 95. She had a full and very productive life as mother, grandmother, great grandmother and military service wife. Her first husband, Seaman 2nd Class Archie L. Henson, was killed in the latter stages of WWII while serving aboard the Aircraft Carrier, the USS Franklin. Her second husband, M/Sgt Robert F. Walker, served in WWII and retired from the US Air Force after 27 1/2 yrs. and died on October 17, 1998.

Vocial is survived by four loving sons and their families: James and Beta Henson, two children and four grandchildren; Owen M. Burt, one child (and one deceased) and three grandchildren; Robert F. Walker; and Michael and Marci Walker, two children and five grandchildren.
