I will miss WD for many reasons, only a few of which are listed above.

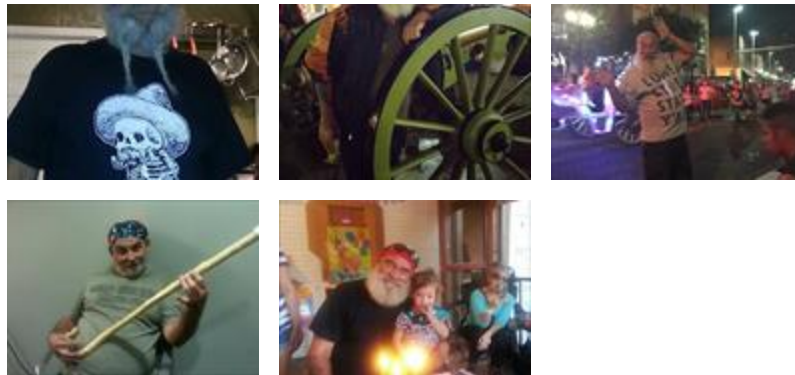
