M/Sgt Wade H. Armstrong Jr., USMC Ret., passed with dignity on Saturday, June 03, 2006 at the age of 84. Wade joined the USMC in 1939 and was stationed in Peking, China on Embassy duty when he was captured by the Japanese. He was a prisoner of war from December 1941 to September 1945. Wade married Pansy Rohmer in 1946. He remained in the USMC, served in Korea and retired in 1959. He was preceded in death by his father, Wade H. Armstrong Sr. and mother, Ida Armstrong Barnes; brothers Jesse, Carroll, Pat, Ray, Samuel, Jimmy and Francis Armstrong; and sisters Alice Rebant and Susie Dabbs. He is survived by his wife of 60 years, Pansy Armstrong; sons Wade Armstrong III and wife Carolyn, Glenn Armstrong, Mark Armstrong and wife, Sally; daughters, Linda Armstrong, Sharon Hanson and husband Tim, Debbie DeWinne and husband Ernie; and grandchildren, Luke Armstrong, Misty Armstrong, Dustan DeWinne, Dalton DeWinne and Madison DeWinne. A visitation will be held on Tuesday, June 6 at Oak Hills Mortuary, 8332 Fredericksburg Road, from 5:00 - 9pm with a rosary at 7:00 pm.
