On 7 January, he announced to family & friends he would discontinue further treatment, opting to enter Hospice. A lifelong, diehard Dallas Cowboys fan, Wallace promised he would fight as long the Cowboys were in the playoffs. Immediately following the game Saturday night, Wallace called for the removal of head coach, Jason Garrett, and began his journey to the Lord, taking with him nothing more than what he had entered...not a stitch! Today, Wallace wakes up in Heaven, doing what he has done for the past 16 years, post liver transplant, reading the obituaries searching for his own. Well done, Dad, you have concluded this final chapter of an exceptional life in a style only you could have pulled off.
