A gold medalist in Ambur High School , he attended Madras Christian College and the Madras Medical College from where he graduated.

In 1968 he came to Chicago. After a year in training in Chicago he completed his Residency in Pediatrics at the Charity Hospital in New Orleans. In 1969 he married Late. Dr. Joan Ezekiel. In 1974, Walter and Joan moved to San Antonio with two young children. Walter pursued his fellowship in Allergy and Immunology and Joan in Radiology. He established a private pediatric practice focusing on Allergy and Immunology. After Joan's demise in 1991 Walter joined the US Air Force and was Lieutenant Colonel at the Sheppard Air Force Base in Wichita Falls. After retiring, he worked at the Darnell Allergy Clinic in Fort Hood. He has been a member of the Redeemer Lutheran

Church in San Antonio since the time the family moved to the city. He enjoyed singing with the church choir.

Walter was a man of few words and deep faith. He loved his family and cared deeply about his patients. His many close friends will miss a man who only had good things to say about people and whose wide smile eased their anxiety even in the midst of declining health. As the eldest child of his parents, he was looked up to, loved and nurtured by his sisters, Victoria, Emerald, Louise, Ruby and brothers, Livingston and Christopher and their families. He will continue to live in the hearts of his beloved daughter Aruna and son Bennett.
