Warren B. Anderson, born on November 28, 1933, was surrounded by his family during the days that led up to him passing away peacefully on July 16, 2012 into the arms of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. He was born in San Antonio as the youngest of five children to P. Jennings and Stella Olive Anderson. He graduated from Brackenridge High School in 1951. Mr. Anderson was quite the athlete in high school, breaking records in football and track. He played football at Texas A&M and then transferred to Texas A&I to play football. He was awarded a Bachelors of Business Administration Degree from Texas A&I University in 1956. Mr. Anderson was commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant into the Army Signal Corp. He was honorably discharged as a 1st Lieutenant from the Army Reserves in 1965. Mr. Anderson later began his 40 year career as a Real Estate Appraiser and received his M.A.I. Member of the Appraisal Institute in 1974. Mr. Anderson twice served as President of the South Texas Chapter of M.A.I. He was preceded in death by his parents, his brothers Jennings Anderson and Terry Anderson and his sister Lorraine Wilson.
