Wayne E. Maddux passed away the morning of April 17, 2008, in San Antonio, TX, at the age of 78. He was born in Jefferson IA on July 14, 1929. Wayne received his formal education in Iowa. He spent five years in the U.S. Army, serving in Germany and Austria. Wayne worked for the Burroughs Corporation in the Engineering Department for thirty-two years, serving in Des Moines IA, Dallas TX, Waco TX and as Branch Manager in San Antonio for twelve years. After retiring in 1984, he joined another computer company Integrated Systems Analysts, working with them for 14 years, and serving as the National Service Manager until forced to retire again in 1999 due to health problems. His health improved and in recent years, he had become an avid golfer, playing three times a week. He also found time to hunt and fish.
