He was the son of Wayne and Fronnie McCarty. Wayne attended McCollum High School and later embarked on a 25-year career with HEB, where he worked as a truck driver. He mainly drove the hill country routes, allowing him to relish the surrounding scenery. Wayne's exceptional driving skills garnered him a gold ring for achieving a Million Safe Driving Miles. Additionally, he had the privilege of chauffeuring El Rey Feo during Fiesta festivities.

In 1984, Wayne discovered his passion for trail riding after participating in his first trail ride. This resulted in his official membership with the Old Chisholm Trail Riders. Throughout the years, he actively served as the Vice President and sound truck driver for the organization. One of his crucial responsibilities was waking the riders with the traditional cattle call during the morning cattle call. Wayne only missed fulfilling this duty on one occasion. In 1989, Wayne joined the San Antonio Livestock Expo and actively participated in various committees. In his final years with the organization, he served on the Trail Ride Committee.

Wayne enjoyed spending time with his family and enjoyed watching his kids and grandkids play sports and was always their biggest fan. Wayne truly was the best husband, dad and often earned the best grandpa award. Wayne McCarty was a loving husband to his wife Trudy for 53 years; and awesome

father to three children (and spouses) Scott (Karen), Perry (Alicia), Kimberly (Stephen); nine grandchildren Justin (Aimee), Lauren, Jacob, Taylor (Tyler), Cheyenne (Jacob), Skylar, Aidan, Jackson and Kennedy. He was blessed with 4 great grandchildren, Kinsley, Karsyn, Kolton, and Holton. Wayne also left behind his sister, Sharon; half-brothers Michael and Patrick and step sister Cindy.
