Wayne Hollomon Price passed away peacefully, at her home on May 19, 2011, surrounded by friends and family. Wayne was an Artist, Montessori Teacher, Counselor, and Philanthropist. She is the founder and primary benefactor of the Hollomon Price Foundation, a charitable organization that annually funds environmental causes.
