September 14, 1932 - October 6, 2005

Werner Weisbrod, born on September 14, 1932 in Rhodt, Germany passed away on October 6, 2005 at the age of 73 years after a long battle with cancer. After founding and leading a Drum and Bugle Marching Band for 5 years in Germany, he came to Chicago, Ill. On August 14, 1965, got married and worked for Harig Tool and Die Co. as a Tool Maker for 30 years. He was a hard worker and a good provider, who never missed an opportunity in working overtime, to get ahead. After retirement, he moved the family to San Antonio, TX where his daughter was already living and working as a Pharmacist after graduating from UT in 1990. There he pursued his love of music again and joined the German Club "Beethoven Mäennerchor" and enjoyed singing with them. Later, he also became a member of the S.A. Liederkrauz Choir and loved to be a part of that group, especially when they performed in concerts. He was also a member of the Germania Club and enjoyed their songs and friendship of many. He was preceded in death by his mother, Wilhelmina Schneider, aunt and uncles, as well as his brother, Helmut Weisbrod. Survivors include his wife of 40 years, Helen W. Weisbrod, daughter, Karen I. Pierce and husband, Michael R. Pierce, 3 grandchildren, Matt, age 22, Nicole, age 20 and Christopher, age 6. Other relatives living in Germany are sister-in-law, Sonja Weisbrod; nephew, Fredy Weisbrod and his family; numerous cousins and sister-in-law, Aurelia Czuday and her family; also brother-in-law, Adolf Hanert, living in Spain.
