



## Wilburn Pierce Grisham

March 26, 1919 - November 2, 2011

Wilburn Pierce Grisham, Jr. born on March 26, 1919 in Electra, Texas passed away on November 2, 2011 at the age of 92. Pierce served his country in the United States Army Air Force from 1941 to 1945. He is preceded in death by his beloved wife Lucille Grisham, and parents Wilburn and Ada Grisham. Survivors include his children, Gary D Grisham, Gayla D Edwards, step-sons Gary D Zintgraff and Robert N Zintgraff. Pierce attended North Texas State, receiving a Bachelors of Science in History and Trinity University receiving a Masters Degree in School Administration. For the 35 years he served as a teacher for the San Antonio Independent School District. He taught American and Texas history at Page Junior High School and ended as Dean at Sam Houston High School. After he retired from teaching, he joined the staff at the Alamo as a Docent and gave guided tours of the Alamo. He made history come alive for thousands of visitors over the years.
