William Joseph Beckham, born on May 26, 1957 in Newark, Ohio, went to be with the Lord on April 21, 2007 in San Antonio, Texas. He was a 1975 graduate of Utica High School in Utica, Ohio and a 2005 graduate of the University of the Incarnate Word, where he received a B.A. in Psychology and Occupational Development. William was employed with Southwest Research Development for 24 years. He was a worship leader and songwriter at Destiny Church for 17 years, as well as abroad. William was preceded in death by his father, William M. Beckham. He is survived by his loving mother, Gertrude “Trudy” Beckham; sister, Patty Ann Whittington and husband, Brad; brother, Jon Beckham and wife, Becky; nieces, Natalie Ann Harris and husband, Tim, Joni A.
