William Joseph Breda, 93 (age) died January 27, 2019. Bill was born on February 13, 1925 in Cambridge, Massachusetts.

He proudly served in the military during World War II, the Korean Conflict and the Vietnam War. Among his many medals and commendations, He received the Bronze Star. He served in the U.S. Navy from February, 1943 to March, 1946; then as a reservist until joining the U.S. Army from January, 1951 thru March, 1968. He then served as an ROTC instructor at Burbank High School from August 1968 thru January, 1985.

Bill was a sports enthusiast and enjoyed umpiring, and refereeing for most of the years he lived in San Antonio, officiating games until 2007 throughout South Texas, including football, baseball, softball, basketball, volleyball.

Bill married Barbara Ray, who preceded him in death in 2010, after 60 wonderful years of marriage. They had seven children, William Joseph Breda, Jr., who preceded them in death and Martha Breda Shank, James Edward Breda and wife, Deborah Breda; Michael Breda and wife, Eileen Breda; Patricia Breda Thompson and Gerald Lee Casey; Robert John Breda and Darlene Breda; Carol Breda Morris; and David Paul Breda and Sharon Floyd. His children blessed him with 14 grandchildren and 21 great grandchildren.
