



William Arnold Lowry

July 9, 1952 - May 8, 2026

William Arnold Lowry was born July 9, 1952, in San Antonio, Texas to William Garcia Lowry and Irene Rodriguez Lowry. He passed away on May 8, 2026 at the age of 73.

Mr. Lowry honorably served his Country in the U.S. Airforce during the Vietnam Conflict. Following his Military Career, he was a peace officer with the Bexar County Sheriff's office before joining the San Antonio Police Department where he retired in 2011 after 31 years of service.

He was a member of Masonic Lodge #8 AF @ AM and an accomplished musician during his life. William played with numerous orchestras and bands beginning at a very early age and continued performing until two years ago, when his health began to decline. He suffered from renal failure and survived five years of daily peritoneal dialysis administered by his wife, Anita Lowry.

He was preceded in death by his parents; brothers: Richard and George Rodriguez; and his sister, Jeanette Montoya. Survivors include his wife, Anita Snow Lowry; two sons: William Lowry and wife Cindy, and Michael Lowry and wife Yvette; sister: Sylvia Rodriguez; 7 grandchildren; and 3 great-grandchildren.
