Bill was a life time resident of San Antonio. He graduated from Southwest Texas State University and also Luther Rice Seminary. He worked for many years as a teacher, principal and retired as Superintendent of Schools, for the Harlandale School District. Southwestern Theological Seminary dedicated the William R. Marshall Center for Theological Studies in his honor. He was the director of the Seminary's San Antonio Extension Center in the mid 1980's.
