Winifred Mary Morris, Win age 91, of San Antonio, passed away on December 10, 2015. She was born on November 12, 1924, in Liverpool England to the late Harold and Mabel Fitzroy. As a teenager during WWII she served as a volunteer fire warden in Liverpool, England. Her parent's home was destroyed by a German bomb while she, her parents and sisters took shelter under the stairs where they were uninjured. Following the war, Win worked in Liverpool in many jobs including green grocer and theater manager. She and her family immigrated to San Antonio in 1963 to be near her sister Ivy and her family. Win worked primarily as a homemaker and raising her family. She became a US citizen in 1968. In 1979 she met her future husband, John Morris. They were married December 31, 1981. Win and John loved to go dancing and they also traveled extensively until her health began to fail in 2014. Win was a member of the Eastern Star. She was preceded in death by her parents and two sisters: Muriel Fitzroy and Ivy Hegarty. She is survived by her husband, John Little Morris; two sons: Stuart Brown wife Pamela and David Brisbane wife Gigi; one sister, Edith Bolton; four grandchildren; one great-grandchild; and three nephews.
