Yolanda A. Huron went to be with our Heavenly Father on June 30, 2020 in San Antonio, Texas at the age of 62. She was born on July 5, 1957 to Felipe and Nicolasa Arredondo. Yolanda is survived by her loving husband of 40 years, Ricardo Huron; children, Roxanne Huron, Roy Huron; sisters, Hilda Arredondo, Norma Valadez, Sylvia Sanchez; brothers, Roger Arredondo, Henry Arredondo, Richard Arredondo, numerous nieces and nephews and other family members. She is preceded in passing by her son, Ricardo Huron, Jr.; brother, Phillip Arredondo and parents Felipe and Nicolas Arredondo. Yolanda worked 40 plus years at the San Antonio State Hospital. Just 10 months after retiring from the State Hospital, she returned there to continue doing what she loved. For 20 years, Yolanda dedicated her life to volunteerism. She was a CCD teacher for 12 of those years, instructing children between the ages of five and six. As an active contributor to church festivities, Yolanda was also a pillar of strength to Mission San Juan Capistrano, the church she attended with her family for 30 years. Yolanda was also a volunteer for CASA and proudly spoke up against child abuse. At one point, she gracefully stood by a child's side in court. She also served as a hospice volunteer for several years. Yolanda truly had a heart of gold. She is and will always be loved and greatly missed.

“ I had the privilege of partnering with Yolanda as her CASA Supervisor. In Yolanda’s 21 years as a volunteer she advocated for the best interest of 46 children in 15 abuse and neglect cases. Yolanda was the supreme example of constancy in the lives of the children on her cases. It is not unusual that cases experience numerous changes of caseworkers, change of placements and schools, however, Yolanda was the one constancy for the children, in addition for the court, newly assigned caseworkers, placements and schools. She was extremely dedicated to the children that she advocated for, taking them to different CASA functions such as Art and Soul and events in San Antonio. Yolanda was a strong, quite woman with an amazing spirit. Yolanda had a unique ability to effectively communicate, bond with children and successfully collaborate with various parties on her cases. I never met any one on any of her abuse and neglect cases that had a negative thing to say about Yolanda. This is amazing in our adversarial arena of Children's Court and abuse cases. Yolanda was a voracious learner, she took advantage of ongoing training opportunities provided by CASA and community organizations. Even though Texas CASA requires 12 hours of ongoing training per fiscal year, Yolanda always accumulated in excess of 35 hours per fiscal year.

Yolanda is an example identified in 1 Peter 4:10 "As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God"

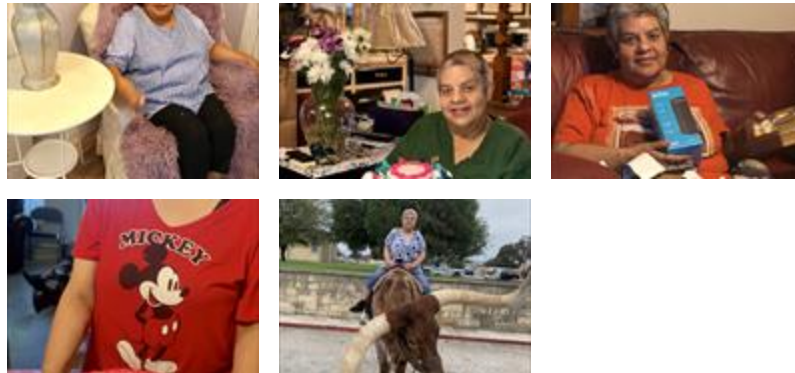
