



Yolanda Morales Timberlake

January 1, 1945 - August 24, 2018

Yolanda Morales began adventuring long before she became Yolanda Timberlake and our Mother. She talked quite a bit about her time in Civil Air Patrol at Edgewood High School and just as often about her time as a Candy Striper at the hospital in downtown San Antonio. In later years she not only survived a shattering blow of becoming a widow but in time surpassed the basics of being a single mother of three children. As we became adults it was no surprise there was no empty nest syndrome for her.

She picked up her education where she left off only this time it was just for fun. She studied at San Antonio College for a while and had her own apartment all on her own. As her adult children began to spread to different states she was free to follow. Sometimes to help grandchildren but mostly to be with her family.

She always had her own home just close enough to help her kids and just far away to enjoy more of her own life experiences. She resumed college once again enjoying Art classes and learned sign language with a goal to work with deaf children. In her quieter years, she'd say "I guess, as long as I'm learning something every day I'm not wasting my life away". Her life was a true miracle, overcoming devastating obstacles.

She loved her kids and their kids and others near or far away. She loved music of all types. It was her easy way of visiting exotic places and places of the past. She always kept great faith in God, family and eventually herself. Medically close to death with no hope of recovering, several times in her adult

life, she did recover. To ask her how that could be possible she offered this “I know I won’t die one minute before or one minute after God is ready for me to go.”

Yolanda Timberlake was preceded in death by her parents Refugio Ballarta Morales and Antonio Morales, sister Rachel Flores and grandson David Ashly Dean. She is survived by sisters Eloisa and Terry, children Antonette, James and Lisa, grandchildren Mellissa, Tina, Michael, Alan, Natashia, Daniel, Morgan, Asher and great grandchildren Jeran, Aiden, Alan, Adelaida, Damion, Isaac, Rowan (coming soon), Emlin and Jackson. She is loved and will be missed.

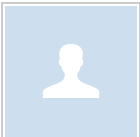
