



Yvonne Herrera Steele

November 28, 1966 - August 20, 2021

Yvonne Herrera Steele, 54, of San Antonio was called home by the Lord after a courageous seven-year battle with a rare form of cancer.

In her teen years, Yvonne modeled, studied dance and participated in beauty contests. A 1984 graduate of John Marshall High School, she also attended UTSA, where she earned her bachelor's degree and was the Most Outstanding Student in UTSA's College of Business for 2004. Yvonne interned with the Veterans Administration, IRS and other organizations. She worked for a construction company and automobile dealership before accepting a position at Wells Fargo, where she was employed for almost 20 years as a human resources project manager.

Yvonne lived her life out loud and got the most out of every minute. Even after she was diagnosed with cancer, she continued to live her life to the full -- and was grateful for every day. And while the last month of Yvonne's life was especially painful and difficult, she never lost hope or faith -- and endured those final days with humor, grace and dignity.

One of Yvonne's favorite quotes was by Booker T. Washington: "You measure the size of the accomplishment by the obstacles you had to overcome to reach your goals," In her lifetime, Yvonne overcame many obstacles and accomplished much, though the time she was given to reach her goals was relatively short.

Yvonne was preceded in death by her father Manuel A. Herrera. She is survived by her mother, Minerva Herrera Schattenberg and her husband Paul;

older brother Richard; younger brother Rodney, his wife Crissy and their sons Logan and Brandon; uncle Frank Fuentes and wife Gina; uncle Rueben Fuentes and wife Dorothy; cousin Valerie Pannell husband Brian: cousin Roxanne Fuentes; cousin Rebecca Vargas, her husband Roland and their children Adrian and Ashley; cousin Ryan Fuentes and wife Destiny and their children Jackson and Lorelei; and numerous other relatives.

A memorial service for Yvonne will be celebrated at 1 p.m. Sunday, Aug. 29 in the Mission Park North Funeral Chapel, 3401 Cherry Ridge, San Antonio.

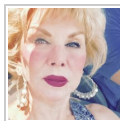

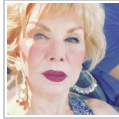
